

Diocesan update on Covid Regulations

Effective Thursday, Feb 17, 2022

-Parish social, public events and gatherings, including Synod discussion group meetings, capacity will increase to 50 people indoors and 100 people outdoors.

-Masks and physical distancing are still required for all church services and in office settings.

Effective Tuesday March 1, 2022

- capacity limits in all indoor public settings, including churches, will be lifted.
- Proof of vaccination requirements for all settings, including churches, will be lifted
- -Masks and physical distancing are still required for all church services and in office settings.

Season of Lent

For our Lenten observances, including Ash Wednesday Masses and liturgical services, all churches can be open to full capacity for the first time in two years.

Ashes may be distributed according to usual custom, with ashes placed on foreheads.
