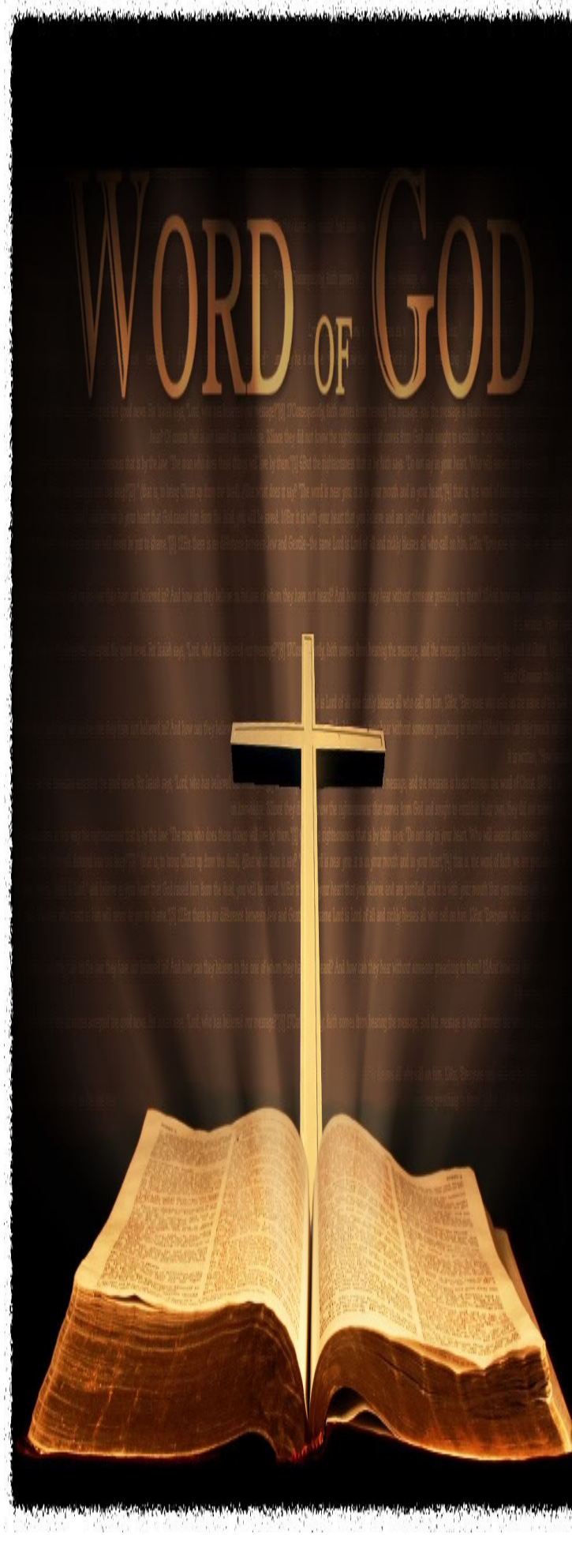

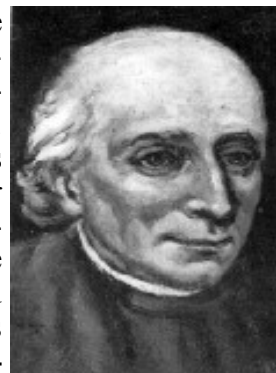
### PRAYER FOR OUR PRIESTS
