





There is a huge panic in Ukrainian cities because of the Russian invasion. There is no chance for a normal life so the people are escaping from the eastern parts of Ukraine.

Solution

The Pallottine parishes in Ukraine, especially in Kyiv, Odesa, Zhytomyr and Lviv receive more and more families asking for shelter. The adaptation of the various rooms for the arriving people is needed, water, food and hygiene products.

SYNOD 2021-2023, Journeying Together What does Pope Francis say about the synodal process? "Consultation of the faithful must be followed by discernment on the part of the Bishops chosen for the task, united in the search for a consensus that springs not from worldly logic, but from common obedience to the Spirit of Christ. Attentive to the sensus fidei of the People of God - 'which they need to distinguish carefully from the changing currents of public opinion' - the members of the Assembly offer their opinion to the Roman Pontiff so that it can help him in his ministry as universal Pastor of the Church...When it is therefore a question involving the faith itself, the consensus ecclesiae...is the outcome of the working of the Spirit, the soul of the one Church of Christ."

SYNOD 2021-2023, Journeying Together In 2015, the Diocese of St. Catharines embarked on a discernment process to determine priorities and to develop a five-year-plan for the diocese. Based on the results of the discernment process, our diocesan synod was to begin in the fall of 2020, but had to be cancelled due to the COVID -19 pandemic. A lot of time, energy and resources went into these diocesan projects, and all of it remains valued and useful. The information from the discernment process and the work done to prepare for the diocesan synod will be combined with the results of the diocesan phase of the Synod on Synodality so that under the leadership of Bishop Bergie, we build plans for the future of our diocese.
