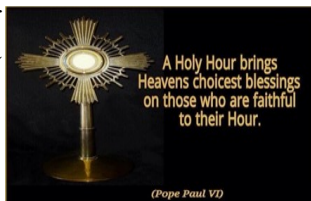
FAITH FORMATION GROUP
