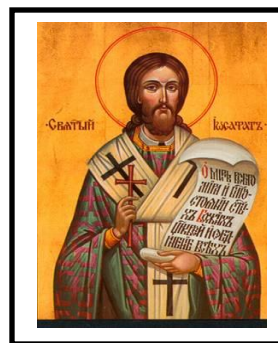

The refugee sponsorship process is usually facilitated by means of a "Sponsorship Agreement" concluded between a diocese, eparchy or other religious or community organization, and the federal government.
