### NOVEMBER † MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS

In the Catechism of the Catholic Church we read: “The Church gives the name purgatory to that final purification of the elect, which is quite distinct from the punishment of the damned” (#1031). “From the earliest times the Church...has offered prayers for the dead, particularly the Eucharistic Sacrifice...The Church recommends alms, gaining of indulgences, and penances for the benefits of the dead” (#1032).
