



RECITATION OF THE HOLY ROSARY

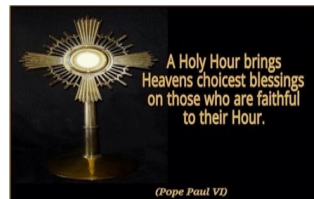
The Rosary is recited everyday during Advent starting at 12:00PM. Only the Joyful Mysteries will be recited. Everyone is welcome.
