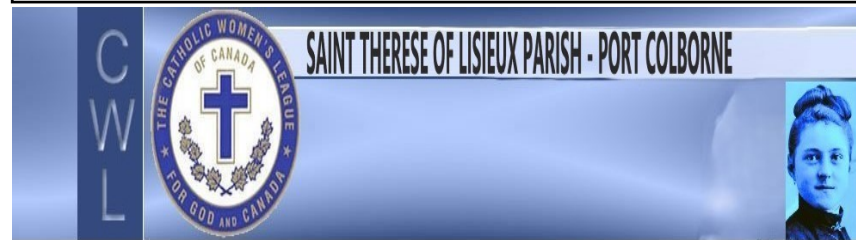

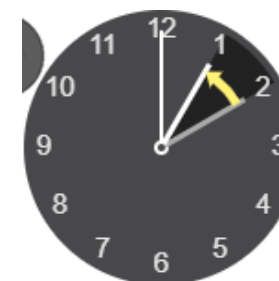

## PRIESTS DIOCESAN FALL STUDY

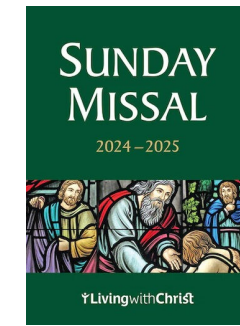
