Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence.

All persons who have completed their fourteenth year of age are bound by the law of abstinence.

Those who have completed their eighteenth year of age are bound by the law of fasting up to the beginning of their sixtieth year.

The law of abstinence forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, the products of milk or condiments made of animal fat. **The law of abstinence is for every Lenten Friday too!**

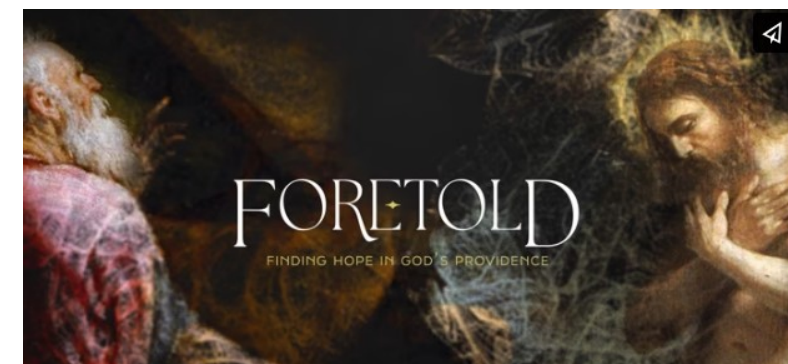
