CONFIRMATION

Bishop Bergie has informed us the Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated at St. Therese of Lisieux Parish on Sunday, April 12 at the 9:00 AM Mass. All Candidates must be a baptized Roman Catholic. Sponsors must be a baptized Roman Catholic who has received First Communion and Confirmation, over sixteen years of age and not a biological or adoptive parent of the Candidate. An information night for parents, Candidates and Sponsors will be held in the Parish Hall on Wednesday, October 8 starting at 6:00 PM. Attendance of at least one parent of each Candidate is mandatory. Children are welcome.

First Confessions will be celebrated at St. Therese of Lisieux Parish on Wednesday, February 25 starting at 6:00 PM.
